Agenda item: Approve Meeting Minutes

Agenda item: Pickleball Team Challenge Update

Discussion:

Started yesterday – the clubs providing players were Greencroft, Boars head, Farmington and Glenmore. This will only run for the month of May – if there is interest, they will probably do another one. Teddy added that it is too bad that the largest group in Charlottesville (i.e. those not affiliated with a private club) has not been able to participate in this league. She thinks that we should offer this to the general CEVA population. Kayla will reach out to Jim to get more information. She said she would ask people in her classes if they were interested.

Agenda item: Key Rec Center Updates

Discussion:

Gene told the Board that we lost Monday night for pickleball , probably because of the lack of people showing up. Additionally, Mike is looking for a pb instructor to provide instruction for beginners, it would be up to the instructor to pick

out day and time, it would likely be after 5 and he would like a volunteer, but is willing to consider paying. Gene was wondering if the board would like to send an email out to the community regarding this. Also there will be a summer camp starting at the end of June; asked Mike if he would consider giving us some evenings, but nothing has been decided. There have not been many people showing up recently. Teddy's thoughts – 2 years of pandemic moved lots of people outside – and think it may have a long-lived effect. Perhaps define a pathway for people to move to Key Rec. Summer programming starts around June 23rd. It is upon the Board to decide who is the audience most likely to play indoors in the summer. And target them. Teddy mentioned that if targeting the older population, they may not want to play in evenings. Gene feels that we will get enough players – looking at Monday and Thursday. Teddy asked what about senior round robins. Kayla suggested something thematic. Gene said that he doesn't think the people coming to Key need an incentive – just coming for fun and exercise. Kayla will reach out to some people who might be able to provide instruction @ key.

Agenda item: Membership Renewal **Presenter:** Teddy/Kayla

Discussion:
